

David E. Johnstone, MD, FRCPC, FACC

Dr. Johnstone is the Clinical Director of the Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute and Professor, Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry at the University of Alberta. His professional interests include congestive heart failure, access to cardiac services, best practices and clinical outcomes studies. He was a member of the Alberta Wait Times Management Steering Committee and is Co-chair of the Alberta Cardiac Tertiary Network.

He was a council member of the Canadian Cardiovascular Society and has served on many of the Society's Practice Guideline Committees; he chaired the Society's first Consensus Conference on the Diagnosis and Management of Congestive Heart Failure (1993). He has been a governor of the American College of Cardiology. He served as President of the Canadian Cardiovascular Society (2002-2004). He has been a board member of the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Nova Scotia and Alberta and was chair of the Cardio/Cerebrovascular Research Advisory Council of Canada. He was chairman of the Improving Cardiovascular Outcomes of Nova Scotia (ICONS) Steering Committee (1997-2002) and Medical Advisory to the Cardiac Advisory Council of Nova Scotia.

Dr. Johnstone received his Undergraduate and Medical degrees from McGill University. He received his cardiology training at the Toronto General Hospital and post doctoral training at Yale University. He was a long serving member of the Division of Cardiology at Dalhousie University, Halifax and was Head of the Division from 1990-2000.
