Poster Board Presentation Guidelines**

Posters are considered a snapshot of your work and intended to engage colleagues in a dialog about the work, or to be a summary that will encourage a reader to want to learn more.

- Posters cannot be larger than 4' x 6'
- Push pins and velcro for mounting posters will be provided by the conference organizers
- Posters will be displayed side-by-side
- Posterboards will be assigned with the title attached to the board; authors should hang posters only in their assigned location.
- A poster should be as self-explanatory as possible, so that there is ample time for in-depth technical discussions.
- Follow the schedule that outlines the time for mounting and removing the posters.
- Posters should be mounted by 07:30 on Friday, May 24 and removed no earlier than 14:30 on May 25.
